

CODE OF ETHICS

It is the responsibility of each college or university to inform any person who represents that institution of the CACRAO Code of Ethics, which will be in effect at all CACRAO sponsored Educational Opportunity Programs (Ed-Op Program). Each institutional representative must respect the rights of other institutions.

- *One official representative is considered adequate at an Ed-Op program. If more than one representative is needed, those present must confine all activities to the assigned space.*
- *Standing in front of your table is not permitted; representatives are to remain behind their assigned table. Allow students to approach your table of their own accord. Calling to or directing students to your table is not permitted.*
- *All institutional representatives indicating they will attend a program should arrive on time and stay until the program is scheduled to end.*
- *All institutional representatives should have an adequate supply of materials to give to students.*
- *Group presentations are not permitted in arena settings where a number of institutions share common quarters. Such presentations discourage students from exploring all of their options.*
- *The use of overly conspicuous exhibits as promotional devices is prohibited. Audio/visual equipment, videos, computers, large displays that exceed or obstruct the view of adjacent booths and balloons are not permitted.*
- *Distributed educational information must be limited to printed materials which are accurate and tasteful. Handouts such as key chains, pens, pennants, balloons, balls, plastic bags, food and candy are not permitted.*
- *Cell phones, Bluetooths and iPhones should be turned off and stored for the duration of the Ed-Op Program.*
- *Applications for admission may be distributed, but not completed at Ed-Op Programs. Offering on-site admission is also not permitted during Ed-Op Programs.*
- *CACRAO members should display the highest levels of decorum and avoid any unprofessional behavior that would disgrace the CACRAO organization or that would infringe upon the rights of their fellow members. A professional demeanor should be maintained with both students and colleagues during an Ed-Op program.*
- *CACRAO member institutions may host Ed-Op Programs only with prior approval from either the NC or SC Scheduling Committees. In the event that the Scheduling Committee feels it is necessary to hold a program at a member institution, the following policies apply:*
 1. *The host institution will participate on an equal standing with all other institutions and no special incentives will be offered for students.*
 2. *Refreshments (if provided) should be for college representatives only.*
 3. *Hosting institutions are not obligated to accommodate representatives who did not receive a specific invitation, did not respond to an invitation, or did not submit a required participation fee.*

The primary purpose of an Ed-Op Program is to provide an opportunity for high school juniors and seniors to be exposed to the many types of post-secondary educational opportunities available to them, while also exploring their specific interests.

Institutions repeatedly out of compliance with the Code of Ethics and guidelines that follow will be reported to the Chair of the Ethics Committee. Unprofessional behavior will not be tolerated.

Directions to East Rutherford High School (from suggested hotels – 35 mins from Hampton in Shelby, 1 hour from Gastonia hotels):

From Gastonia hotels, get on I-85 South. Take Exit 10B (US 74 West) through the town of Shelby (past the Hampton in Shelby) and past signs for Boiling Springs (you'll be on 74 a total of about 24 miles)....

From Hampton Inn in Shelby, turn right onto 74 West. You'll travel through Shelby and past signs for Boiling Springs (you'll be on 74 a total of about 13 miles)....

Bear right onto Ellenboro Road (US 74 Business -West) and go 7.8 miles.

Turn right onto East High Road and go .4 miles.

East Rutherford High School will be on the right.

****Currently, there is a detour on 74 West, and it may still be there. If so, after travelling through Shelby, you'll be directed to turn right onto Peachtree Street. Continue 1.5 miles, and you'll be directed to turn left onto Lattimore Road. Drive 2.3 miles, and you'll meet back up with 74 West. Almost immediately, you'll bear right onto 74 BR-W/Ellenboro Road. Go about 7.8 miles on Ellenboro Road. Turn right onto East High Road, which is right next to a gas station called East Qwik Stop. East Rutherford High School will be on the right.**

Directions to Chase High School (from East Rutherford – 15 mins):

Turn left out of East Rutherford's parking lot and continue .4 miles on East High Road.

Turn right onto US-74 Business and go 1.3 miles.

Turn left on South Broadway Street (US 221-Alt) and go about 3.4 miles. You'll cross over Hwy 74 along the way.

Bear right on Chase High Road and go 2.9 miles.

Chase High School will be on the left.

Take Exit 178 (US 221 N) toward Rutherfordton.

Turn right and travel about 5.5 miles on 221 North.

You'll travel through downtown Rutherfordton; continue straight. [*Some GPS units may say the school is on the right in the downtown area; this is the old school's location. Continue straight until you leave the downtown area see the high school on the left.]

Directions to Cleveland Community College (from RS Central)

[*Recommend stopping in Shelby for dinner; there are several restaurants along US 74.]

Turn right out of RS Central's parking lot and drive back down 221 to US 74.

Take left ramp onto US 74 East and go about 23 miles, through Shelby.

Turn left onto South Post Road (NC 180 – at the intersection there is a gas station/Bojangles) and go .8 miles.

Cleveland Community College will be on the right.

Directions to Gastonia hotels (from Cleveland Community College):

Turn left out of CCC's parking lot and go back toward 74.

Turn left onto 74 East and go about 12 miles.

Merge onto I-85 N and continue about 10 miles into Gastonia.

For Holiday Inn Express take Exit 17 and turn left onto N Chester St/321. Go .3 miles and turn left onto Rankin Lake Road, and a quick left onto Broadcast Street.

For Hampton Inn take Exit 20 and turn left onto N New Hope Road. In 400 yds, turn right onto Remount Road (past Cracker Barrell) and arrive at Hampton Inn on the right.

Oakland becomes Philadelphia Church Road; continue .7 miles.

Turn left onto Ratchford Drive and go .3 miles.

Directions to East Gaston High School (from North Gaston – 20 mins):

[*Recommend a caravan or following someone with GPS, as this is all back roads!]

Turn left out of North Gaston and continue .3 miles on Ratchford Drive.

Turn left onto Philadelphia Church Road and go .2 miles (you'll pass a railroad crossing sign but don't cross the tracks...the turn for Carr Road is right across from Gwin Materials).

Turn right onto Carr Road and go .8 miles.

Turn right onto Kiser Dairy Road and go .5 miles.

Make a sharp left turn onto Dallas-Stanley Hwy/NC 275 (at Texaco) and go 3 miles.

Turn right onto McKenon Road/2001 Road (there's a curve right before this turn, and you'll see a gas station on your right; if you pass Nutena Feed Store, you've gone too far!). Go .3 miles.

Turn left on Shadowbrook Drive and go 1.3 miles. (Speed limit is 35; be careful!)

Turn right on Hickory Grove Road and go 1.8 miles (drive until you see Hickory Grove Home Development; the turn onto South Lane is in 200 yds).

Turn left on South Lane Road and go .3 miles.

Turn right onto W Main St (NC 27 W)

Make a slight right hand turn onto N Central Ave. and go 1.7 miles

N Central Ave. becomes South Point Road, and will lead you to South Point High School, on the right.

At first stoplight, turn left onto E Main Avenue and go .8 miles.

Turn left onto 274/Gastonia Hwy (this turn is at CVS pharmacy), then go 2.5 miles.

Turn left to take ramp onto I-85 North (there's construction; the on-ramp is right after Bojangles). Go 4 miles on 85.

Take exit 17 and turn right onto US 321 (N. Chester Street).

Take an almost immediate right onto Radio Street.
