

CODE OF ETHICS

It is the responsibility of each college or university to inform any person who represents that institution of the CACRAO Code of Ethics, which will be in effect at all CACRAO sponsored Educational Opportunity Programs (Ed-Op Program). Each institutional representative must respect the rights of other institutions.

- *One official representative is considered adequate at an Ed-Op program. If more than one representative is needed, those present must confine all activities to the assigned space.*
- *Standing in front of your table is not permitted; representatives are to remain behind their assigned table. Allow students to approach your table of their own accord. Calling to or directing students to your table is not permitted.*
- *All institutional representatives indicating they will attend a program should arrive on time and stay until the program is scheduled to end.*
- *All institutional representatives should have an adequate supply of materials to give to students.*
- *Group presentations are not permitted in arena settings where a number of institutions share common quarters. Such presentations discourage students from exploring all of their options.*
- *The use of overly conspicuous exhibits as promotional devices is prohibited. Audio/visual equipment, videos, computers, large displays that exceed or obstruct the view of adjacent booths and balloons are not permitted.*
- *Distributed educational information must be limited to printed materials which are accurate and tasteful. Handouts such as key chains, pens, pennants, balloons, balls, plastic bags, food and candy are not permitted.*
- *Cell phones, Bluetooths and iPhones should be turned off and stored for the duration of the Ed-Op Program.*
- *Applications for admission may be distributed, but not completed at Ed-Op Programs. Offering on-site admission is also not permitted during Ed-Op Programs.*
- *CACRAO members should display the highest levels of decorum and avoid any unprofessional behavior that would disgrace the CACRAO organization or that would infringe upon the rights of their fellow members. A professional demeanor should be maintained with both students and colleagues during an Ed-Op program.*
- *CACRAO member institutions may host Ed-Op Programs only with prior approval from either the NC or SC Scheduling Committees. In the event that the Scheduling Committee feels it is necessary to hold a program at a member institution, the following policies apply:*
 1. *The host institution will participate on an equal standing with all other institutions and no special incentives will be offered for students.*
 2. *Refreshments (if provided) should be for college representatives only.*
 3. *Hosting institutions are not obligated to accommodate representatives who did not receive a specific invitation, did not respond to an invitation, or did not submit a required participation fee.*

The primary purpose of an Ed-Op Program is to provide an opportunity for high school juniors and seniors to be exposed to the many types of post-secondary educational opportunities available to them, while also exploring their specific interests.

Institutions repeatedly out of compliance with the Code of Ethics and guidelines that follow will be reported to the Chair of the Ethics Committee. Unprofessional behavior will not be tolerated.

- Left out of lot onto Albany - veer **RIGHT** onto Edgewcombe Ave.
- Go through 1st light (Pass Fayetteville State on Right)
- Turn **RIGHT** onto Murchison Rd **THEN TAKE IMMEDIATE LEFT** onto Filter Plant Rd
- Veer **RIGHT** after 0.2 miles- go to stop sign at Bragg Blvd.
- Turn **RIGHT** onto Bragg Blvd – Go 0.5 miles
- Turn **LEFT** onto Glenville (Just passed Pearl St./mini strip mall on left)
- Go to Stop Sign (you see the school in front of you) turn **RIGHT** – pull into the lot and turn left and drive towards the tennis courts. Park by tennis courts- program is in the Gym

- Turn LEFT out of lot – Go 0.2 miles
- Turn RIGHT onto Lakewood Dr. – Go 2 miles
- Turn RIGHT onto Fisher Rd – Go 1 mile
- Turn RIGHT onto Cumberland Rd – **Turn LEFT at the first stoplight to stay on Cumberland** – Go 0.5 miles
- Turn LEFT onto Hope Mills Rd. – Go 2.6 miles
- Turn Right onto Raeford Rd – Go 1.2 miles
- Turn LEFT onto All-American Freeway (Just passed Roxie Ave and overpass) – Go 1.2 miles
- Take Cliffdale Rd Exit
- Turn RIGHT off of exit – Go 0.7 miles to Fayetteville Academy
- **TURN LEFT AT THE ENTRANCE AFTER THE FAYETTEVILLE ACADEMY SIGN –GO STRAIGHT BACK (PROGRAM IS IN THE GYM)**

- Turn left onto Skibo go less than 1 mile
- Turn Right onto SWAIN ST.(Logan's on your left/ and just before the FORD sign)
- Turn Right onto Bragg Blvd/NC-24E/NC-87 follow for 4.4 miles.
- Pass Sharkies and Sparkies....you'll turn left at the 2nd light after **Sparkies** to stay on Hwy 24 East. Follow for about 8 miles
- Turn right at traffic light on Clinton Rd.(Cape Fear H.S. sign)
- School is on the left. Do not turn in until you pass the school. Turn left to enter at the second entrance. You will be between the middle school and the high school.

- Turn right out of school lot onto Clinton Rd, go back to light
- Turn left onto NC-24 follow for 6.5 miles (You will come up on a huge American Flag on your left and three jumbo green signs above the road (get in the left lane)
- Turn left at light onto N Eastern Blvd/I-95BR S/US-301S(Toward Hope Mills)
- Follow for 3 miles
- Turn Right on Owen Dr. (BP Gas/Quality Inn)(To 401 Sign)
- First Light...turn left onto Southern Ave. follow for 2.9 miles
- Turn Left on ELK RD(Just after passing Rock Spring Church)
- Take the second right turn lane into "Tiger Country" Drive straight ahead and park to the right side of the building. The program will be in the Cafeteria, you see it there on your left with the glass wall. Enter under the "Welcome to Tiger Country" sign. Drive time 25 minutes.

- Turn right out of Southview's parking lot onto Elk Rd. follow to the end
- Turn Right at the stop sign onto Cameron Rd.
- Take IMMEDIATE LEFT on road with no street sign/it may have one by now
- Take an Immediate right onto I-95 BR follow for 1.7 mi.
- Take a right onto ramp for I-95 N/NC-59/Hope Mills
- Turn left at stop sign
- Turn left again at this next stop sign onto Main Street
- Follow main street, for two miles *****
- You will reach Celebration ST. Turn Left (Grays Creek HS Sign)(It is after you cross over I-95 and it is the first light after passing a lot surrounded by a huge amount of white fencing) Main street will have switched over to Chicken Foot Rd along the way.
- Follow Celebration St. until you see the school on your right.

- (Senior High School is after Junior High School). **Turn right** after passing the second DBHS sign (**Red Concrete DBHS**) onto **Eagle DR.**

- Turn LEFT out of lot onto Ireland – Go 0.7 miles
- Turn RIGHT onto Raeford – Go 0.4 miles
- Turn LEFT onto All-American Freeway (just passed Roxie Ave and an overpass)
- ****THERE IS CONSTRUCTION TAKING PLACE on the Morganton Rd exit SO FOLLOW THIS DETOUR IF IT IS NOT FINISHED**** If detour does not exist take the Morganton Road exit turn left and follow to Bonanza Dr.
- If Detour take Cliffdale Rd exit
- Turn LEFT onto Cliffdale Rd – Go 0.9 miles
- Turn RIGHT onto Skibo Rd – Go 0.8 miles
- Turn LEFT onto Morganton Rd – Go 1.4 miles
- Turn RIGHT onto Bonanza Dr. (Rite Aid/Exxon on corner)
- School is about three/tenths of a mile down on your left. It is the entrance just past the ball field and just past the Westover Schools sign.
- Turn left (you will see a road sign on the right that says Longhorn Dr)
- Go to the stop sign. (You will see the high school straight ahead of you and the middle school to the left) you will park along the side of the high school in the lot to your right) turn right than left to get into the lot.
- You will enter the main entrance with “ Westover High School” above the door.
Program is in the gym down the hall to the left across from Guidance
