Academic Requirements

Freshmen must:

- Graduate in top 75% of high school class *OR*
- Score at least 900 on SAT *OR*
- Score at least 19 on ACT *OR*
- Graduate with at least a 2.7 GPA on the SC Uniform Grading Policy

Upperclassmen must:

- Pass a minimum of 24 credit-hours annually *AND*
- Be meeting Satisfactory Academic Progress at the college
